KEY DIVE SITES

- **The Brother Islands** are among the most renowned dive sites in the Red Sea, offering spectacular wall dives draped with vibrant soft corals and vast gorgonian forests. The surrounding waters teem with life, from large tuna and jackfish to pelagic sharks and graceful mantas.

Big Brother also features two legendary wrecks — the Aida (30–60 m), an Egyptian supply vessel, and the Numidia (10–85 m), a cargo ship resting dramatically along the reef wall.

- **Elphinstone Reef**, famed for steep walls draped in soft corals and gorgonians, features northern and southern plateaus teeming with pelagic life, including oceanic whitetip and hammerhead sharks—perfect for advanced divers seeking thrilling drift dives.
- **Daedalus Reef**, a remote offshore reef and protected marinepark known for its dramatic drop-offs, strong currents, and rich pelagic life.

Embark at Hurghada port, check in by 6pm, complete registration and boat briefing

DAY 2 - SAIL OUT

Sail out, complete 2 check dives at local sites

Explore some of the Red Sea's most remote and iconic dive sites

- Brother islands (3 Dives)
- Daedalus (3 Dives)
- Elphinstone (2 Dives)
- Shona (1 Dive) and Tromby (1 Night Dive)
- Safaga (4 Dives including a night dive and Salem express wreck)

DAY 7 - FINAL DIVE DAY

Last 2 dives at local sites before returning to the marina in Hurghada

DAY 8 - DEPARTURE DAY

Disembark at Hurghada port after breakfast, check-out and transfer to the airport

BOOKING & CANCELLATION

Payment Terms

- A **non-refundable 35% deposit** is required to confirm your booking
- The **balance** must be paid directly to the team in Egypt before **28th April 2026** (*60 days before departure*)

Cancellation Policy

- Cancellations made **within 60 days of departure are non-refundable.**
- **Failure to arrive** will result in no refund
- **Flight cancellations or late arrivals** will not be refunded for unused services
- **Unused dives** from a pre-paid package are non-refundable and non-transferable

FAQs

- **Do I need a visa to enter Egypt?**

Yes, Indian passport holders require a visa to enter Egypt.

ORCA can guide you on the visa process once your spot is confirmed.

- **What level of certification is required for this trip?**

Participants must be Advanced Open Water Divers (AOWD) with a minimum of 25 logged dives.

- **What information and documents are required to confirm my booking?**

Please submit all participant details — including full name, nationality, and passport number — three weeks before your trip. For check-in, you'll also need to provide a copy of your passport, a valid dive certification, and your logbook.

- **What are the check-in and check-out times?**

Check-in is after 6:00 PM on the first day, with the boat setting sail the following morning.

The boat will return to port one day before disembarkation, and check-out is by 10:00 AM on the final day.

- **What currency should I bring for the trip?**

We recommend carrying Euros (EUR) for onboard payments such as equipment rentals. USD and GBP are also widely accepted. It's best to bring small denominations for tips and local purchases.

FAQs

- **Can I join as a non-diver or snorkeler?**

Yes, non-divers are welcome onboard. While you won't participate in scuba diving, you can still enjoy snorkeling at selected sites, relax on deck, or explore the boat amenities.

- **Can I complete any Specialty courses on this trip?**

Yes, Our instructors can offer specialty dive training onboard (e.g. Drift, Deep, Nitrox, etc). Let us know in advance so we can plan your course schedule.

- **Will I need to bring my own dive gear?**

You're welcome to bring your own gear; however, rental equipment is available onboard for those who need it. For comfort and familiarity, we recommend bringing your own mask, fins, and dive computer.

- **Can you accommodate guests with medical conditions?**

We recommend consulting your physician regarding any health requirements for your travel destination. Guests are also required to complete a medical statement before joining the trip. A physician's clearance is mandatory for guests aged 45 and above or for anyone who answers "yes" to any questions on the form.

Please contact us to receive the medical statement and further details.

FAQs

- **Can you accommodate specific dietary requirements (e.g., vegan, vegetarian, pescatarian)?**

Yes, the kitchen can accommodate various dietary preferences and restrictions, including vegan, vegetarian, and pescatarian diets, as well as any food allergies or special requests. Please inform us in advance so we can prepare accordingly.

- **Is WiFi available onboard?**

Yes, Wi-Fi is available onboard for an additional charge. Please note that coverage may be limited, especially while crossing channels. For a more reliable connection, we recommend purchasing a local SIM card upon arrival.

- **Can I use a drone or capture content above water?**

Yes, you may use a drone or other devices to capture above-water content; however, drone usage is restricted in certain areas under Egyptian regulations. Please check with the crew before flying to ensure compliance with local laws and safety guidelines.

- **Are electrical plugs available in the cabins?**

Due to new regulations, electrical plugs have been removed from all cabins. A shared charging station is available on the main deck for guests to use.

Guests requiring power for medical or sleeping devices (e.g., CPAP) will be placed in Cabin 1 or near an accessible outlet. Please inform us in advance for arrangements.

DISCLAIMER

Orca Dive Club shall not be held liable for any disruptions, cancellations, or modifications to the trip or diving schedule arising from the following circumstances, including but not limited to :

- **Visa-related matters**, including delays, rejections, deportation, or refusal of entry by immigration or other authorities
- **Personal reasons**, injuries, or health related concerns once the trip has been confirmed
- **Adverse weather conditions**, or ocean conditions that may affect diving activities
- **Mechanical failures**, including boat or engine breakdowns, that may result in changes to the diving or travel itinerary
